EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER FOUR IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 4 DATED FEBRUARY 13, 1884, A SURVEY FOR A PRIVATE ROAD IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21-19-12 FOR EVAN MYERS, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT HE BEGAN THIS ROAD SURVEY AT A POINT **12.5 FEET EAST** OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21 TO BEGIN THIS PRIVATE ROAD SURVEY.

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 630 AND 631 FOR ROAD NUMBER 261 BY A PETITION BY EVAN MYERS [PACKET 499 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] DATED APRIL 1884, SAID THAT HE BEGAN THIS ROAD SURVEY AT A POINT **12.5 FEET EAST** OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21 FOR THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A **25 FOOT WIDE** ROAD.
