

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 261 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 630 TO 632 PETITIONED BY EVAN MYERS FOR THE LOCATION OF A **PRIVATE** ROAD IN SECTION 2116-10 [PACKET 499 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON APRIL 13 1884, WAS RECOMMENDED BY THE VIEWERS TO BE 25 FEET WIDE FOR THE REASON THAT THE PETITIONER, EVAN MYERS, HAS 120 ACRES OF LAND TO WHICH THERE IS NO ROAD, THAT WAS ESTABLISHED ON APRIL 9, 1884 BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER, AND RECORDED ON MAY 16, 1884 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21-19-12 ON THIS **PRIVATE** ROAD SURVEY. HE COMMENCED THIS ROAD SURVEY AT A POINT 12-1/2' EAST OF THIS STONE.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS **PRIVATE** ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/8TH SECTION LINE FOR 20 CHAINS TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 21-19-12 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) A HEDGE STANDS ON THE RIGHT-OF-WAY WEST OF THE CENTER 4 FEET AT THE SOUTH END AND ABOUT 9 FEET AT THE NORTH END
