

CENTER CORNER SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) H. S. SLEEPER, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 1 ON PAGE 45 OF SURVEY BOOK "A" DATED JULY 1, 1859 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER OF SECTION 22-19-12, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE SET A 3" THICK LIME ROCK MARKED WITH A "C"** FOR THE CENTER OF SECTION 22 EQUIDISTANT FROM THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
 - 1) 40.19 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22
 - 2) 40.19 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22
 - 3) 36.9 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 22
 - 4) 39.6 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 22

- 2) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 47 AND DATED SEPTEMBER 10, 1965, SAID THAT **THERE WAS NO MONUMENT** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 22 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
