

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 66 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 214 DATED SEPTEMBER 9, 1872 TO RANGE OUT THE LINE IN THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 14-19-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 23 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE NOTED: "SEE SURVEY NUMBER 4 TERM 6" FOR THE STONE AT THIS CORNER.
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
 - 1) 598' WEST TO THE PERMANENT CORNER HE SET FOR THE SECOND LOT
 - 2) 1,078' WEST TO THE PERMANENT CORNER HE SET FOR THE FIRST LOT
 - 3) 1,318' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 14 & 23
