

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,  
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) SAMUEL P. DAVIES, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 47, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 46 DATED MAY 14 & 25, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER OF SECTION 24-19-12 AND ALSO TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 INTO EQUAL HALVES BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE SET A LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 24 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST AND SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 24 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,320' WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 23, 24 25 & 26
- 2) 1,320' EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 24
