

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F27001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 TO MONUMENT THE WEST HALF OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 27-19-12 LYING SOUTH TO THE OLD M. K. & T. RAILWAY NOW ABANDONED FOR PROJECT NUMBER 99012-02 DATED JUNE 22, 1999 SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 27 TO BE ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE CENTER OF SECTION 27, BUT IT WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY. HE NOTED IN HIS *SURVEY NOTES*: “THIS AREA AND THIS SECTION IN PARTICULAR [SECTION 27] HAS KNOWN GLO FRAUD AS EVIDENCED BY PREVIOUS SURVEYS.”
- HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:**
- 1) 1,321.27’ WEST TO A 1/2” REBAR WITH HIS “LS 752” CAP SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27
 - 2) 1,321.27’ EAST TO A 5/8” REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SET FOR THE CENTER OF SECTION 27
 - 3) 3,955.38’ EAST TO A 5/8” REBAR OVER THE STONE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27
 - 4) 1,327.88’ NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 27
 - 5) 2,655.76’ NORTH TO THE STONE SET BY EDMISTON IN 1855 FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 27
