

CENTER CORNER SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) POLLY A. JONES, L.S. 1130, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F28002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 FOR THE SURVEY OF TWO TRACTS LYING SOUTH OF THE COTTONWOOD RIVER IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 28-19-12 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 99498-02 DATED MARCH 21, 2000 SHOWS ON HER SURVEY DRAWING THAT SHE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28 TO BE AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS, BUT IT WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

HER SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 2,635.37' WEST TO A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SET ON THIS SURVEY FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28
- 2) 2,653.27' NORTH TO A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SET ON THIS SURVEY FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28
- 3) 1,317.72' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL LOCATION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 28
- 4) 2,635.44' EAST TO A 1/2" REBAR FOUND WITH A "LS 752" CAP FROM A PERVIOUS SURVEY AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28
- 5) 1,326.40' SOUTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HER "LS 1130" CAP SET ON THIS SURVEY FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 28
- 6) 2,652.81' SOUTH TO A 1/2" REBAR FOUND ON THIS SURVEY AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28
