

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 70 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 218 DATED NOVEMBER 7, 1872 TO FIND THE AREA OF THAT PART OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-19-12 SOUTH OF THE COTTONWOOD RIVER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE 1/24 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29 ON **THIS PERMANENT SURVEY.**

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCE:

- 1) 1,312' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 29 & 32
- 2) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN SURVEY F29004 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 BUT NOT DATED FOR A 10 ACRE TRACT IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 29-19-12, HE SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING A "MONUMENT" AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29, BUT HE DOES NOT DESCRIBE THE MONUMENT AND THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE FILES.
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
 - 1) 454.00' WEST TO A "MONUMENT" HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 10 ACRE TRACT
 - 2) 985.22' WEST TO A "MONUMENT" HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE 10 ACRE TRACT
 - 3) 1,315.22' WEST TO A "MONUMENT" AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29
- 3) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN LARGE SURVEY SR #29001 IN THE SURVEY DRAWER FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 BUT NOT DATED, SHOWS A "MONUMENT" AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 29, BUT THERE IS NO DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENT AND THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE FILES.
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
 - 1) 1,315.5' WEST TO A "MONUMENT" AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 29
 - 2) 1,315.5' EAST TO A "MONUMENT" AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 29
- 4) POLLY A. JONES, L.S. 1130, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED NOVEMBER 4, 1999, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 99513-02, SAID THAT **SHE FOUND A 1/2" REBAR ATTRIBUTABLE TO LESLIE M. GOULD** AT THE 1/16TH CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29 PER RESEARCH AT THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE. SHE SAID THAT THIS MONUMENT WAS USED AS IT BEST-FIT GOULD'S DISTANCE FROM A PRIOR SURVEY.
 - 1) **0.55' EAST TO A SIMILAR 1/2" REBAR [ORIGIN UNCERTAIN]**
 - 2) 11.0' WEST TO A ROW OF HEDGE TREES RUNNING NORTH
 - 3) 3.5' WEST TO A LINE OF FENCE RUNNING SOUTH
 - 4) 35.9' NE TO A MASONRY NAIL & 2 WASHERS IN A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 5) 27.55' NW TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF A 2' X 1' X 6.5' CEMENT MARKER
 - 6) 27.8' SOUTH TO A MASONRY NAIL & WASHER IN A FENCE POST
 - 7) 0.5' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE OF COUNTY ROAD 140 EAST-WEST
 - 8) 8.1' EAST TO THE CENTERLINE OF A DRIVE TO THE NORTH

- 5) POLLY A. JONES, L.S. 1130, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F28003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 FOR THE RE-SURVEY OF A TRACT OF LAND

LYING IN THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 29 AND A TRACT LYING IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 28, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 19-12 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 99513-02 DATED APRIL 26, 2000, SHE SHOWS ON HER SURVEY DRAWING THAT **SHE FOUND THE 1/2" REBAR ATTRIBUTABLE TO L. M. GOULD** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29, BUT THE DIMENSIONS INDICATE THAT IT WAS THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE **SOUTHEAST 1/4** OF SECTION 29.

HER SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DIMENSIONS:

- 1) 1,047.04' EAST TO A 1/2" REBAR SHE FOUND ATTRIBUTABLE TO L. M. GOULD [GOULD = 1,047.50']
- 2) 1,314.93' EAST TO A 1/2" SQUARE REBAR SHE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 29 [GOULD = 1,315.50']
- 3) 1,877.51' EAST TO A 1/2" REBAR ATTRIBUTABLE TO L. M. GOULD SHE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF TRACT 2 [GOULD = 1,878.15']
- 4) 3,949.19' EAST TO A 1/2" REBAR ATTRIBUTABLE TO L. M. GOULD SHE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28
