

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 03, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 132 DATED MAY 8, 1882 AT THE REQUEST OF THE JACOB BROTHERS TO SURVEY SECTION 3-19-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE NORTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-19-13 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-19-13 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 3-19-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
  
- 2) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN SURVEY F03002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-13 TO LOCATE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SOUTH HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE FRACTIONAL NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 3-19-13 AND TO LOCATE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE REMAINING 60 ACRES OF THE SOUTH HALF OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SECTION, WHICH WAS DONE BY MEASUREMENT OF THE PERIMETER AND FOUND TO BE AS LOCATED BY SURVEYOR RICE IN 1882 WITH FENCES ON ALL INTERIOR LINES IN THE PROPER LOCATION, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE THAT WAS SET BY RICE IN 1882** AT THE SOUTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-19-13. THIS CORNER IS ALSO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF A 20 ACRE TRACT. THE SURVEY IS NOT DATED AND THERE IS NO DESCRIPTION OF THE SIZE OR TYPE OF STONE THAT HE FOUND.  
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 1,320' WEST TO THE "MONUMENT" IN LINE WITH A HEDGE TO THE EAST AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-19-13 – NOT DESCRIBED
  - 2) 1,320' EAST TO THE "MONUMENT" IN LINE WITH FENCES TO THE WEST & NORTH AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 3-19-13 – NOT DESCRIBED
  - 3) 660' NORTH TO THE "MONUMENT" HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE 20 ACRE TRACT – NOT DESCRIBED
  
- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, IN SURVEY F03001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-13 FOR THE SURVEY OF A 19.96 ACRE TRACT IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 3-19-13 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 84113 DATED SEPTEMBER 13, 1984, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND A 3" X 12" X 18" LIMESTONE WITH A #4 REBAR ON THE SOUTH SIDE** AT THE SOUTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-19-13. THIS CORNER IS ALSO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 19.96 ACRE TRACT. **[NOTE: THIS STONE WAS SET BY DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR C. H. RICE IN A PERMANENT SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 132 IN 1882 – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]**  
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 1,318.75' WEST TO THE #4 REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 3-19-13, AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE 19.96 ACRE TRACT
  - 2) 659.50' NORTH TO THE #4 REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE 19.96 ACRE TRACT
  
- 4) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F03004 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-13 FOR THE SURVEY OF TWO TRACTS IN THE NORTH HALF OF THE NORTHWEST AND NORTHEAST QUARTERS OF SECTION 3-19-13 FOR WANDA STATTLER FOR PROJECT NUMBER 08164-02 DATED JUNE 19, 2008, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THE FOLLOWING NOTE FOR THE SOUTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-19-13: **"SEARCHED FOR STONE FOUND ON PRIOR SURVEY. POSITION NOW FALLS INSIDE A CORNER FENCE POST"**.

- 1) 1,318.75' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS RED "LS 752" CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 3-19-13
- 2) 1,318.37' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 1 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 3-19-13 THAT WAS SET BY RICE IN 1882 IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 132
- 3) 3,941.73' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 3-19-13
