

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 13 EAST**

1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JULY 23, 2014, FOR JOB NUMBER 14148-02, THE SURVEY OF TWO TRACTS IN THE SOUTH 1/2 OF SECTION 33-18-13, SURVEY F33001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 18-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" IRON PIN WITH HIS "S. BROSEMER" CAP** FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-18-13.

- 1) 30.00' NORTH TO A 1/2" X 24" IRON PINE WITH HS "S. BROSEMER" CAP SET FOR A WITNESS CORNER
- 2) 42.75' ESE TO A 40 D SPIKE IN THE TOP OF A BRACE POST
- 3) 36.20' NNW TO A 40 D SPIKE IN THE TOP OF A CORNER FENCE POST
- 4) 6.00' NORTH TO THE CENTERLINE OF THE TRAVELED WAY OF COUNTY ROAD 190 EAST-WEST
- 5) 7.50' WEST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE NORTH EXTENDED

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,317.88' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 1/2" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13
- 2) 522.50' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 1/2" IRON PIN WITH HIS "PS 752 S. BROSEMER" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTH TRACT AS WITNESSED BY THE 1/2" IRON PIN WITH HIS "PS 752 S. BROSEMER" CAP HE SET AT 30 FEET NORTH
- 3) 1,317.88' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13 AND THE P.O.B. OF THE SOUTH TRACT
- 4) 2,635.76' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 752 S. BROSEMER" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13 THAT FELL IN LINE WITH THE FENCE TO THE NORTH
- 5) 3,953.64' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE #5 SQUARER REBAR HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13
- 6) 833.68' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 752 S. BROSEMER" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTH TRACT
- 7) 2,640.68' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 752 S. BROSEMER" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 33-18-13 THAT FELL IN LINE WITH FENCES TO THE SOUTH AND WEST EXTENDED
