

**WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,  
RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 76 OF THE 7<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 224 DATED DECEMBER 18, 1872 TO PART OFF 80 ACRES FROM THE NORTH SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-19-13, SAID THAT "THE GROUND BEING FROZEN COULD NOT SET STONE BUT MARKED CORNERS BY **DRIVING POSTS**" FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 8-19-13 AT 1,320' SOUTH OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-19-13 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 8-19-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,320' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-19-13
- 2) 2,640' EAST TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER ON OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 8-19-13
