

**WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 88 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 19" X 10" X 3"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-13 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY ON DECEMBER 24, 1855.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 20" X 11" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7 & 18-19-13
  - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 20" X 10" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 18 & 19-19-13
  
- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 49, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 230 DATED MAY 7, 1902 ORDERED BY H. B. WILLIAMS TO SURVEY AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO LOCATE AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE NORTHEAST CORNER, THE SOUTHEAST CORNER, AND THE SOUTH AND EAST LINES OF SECTION 13-19-12, APPARENTLY DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13-19-12 ON THE RANGE LINE AS HE RAN THE RANGE LINE FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 12-19-12 SOUTH TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 24-19-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK NUMBER 3 ON PAGE 62, AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS IN PACKET "M 45" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 2 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
