

**NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 664 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 12" X 3-1/2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 18 & 19-19-13 ON JANUARY 28, 1856.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 39.85 CHAINS WEST TO THE 20" X 10" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 18 & 19-19-13 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
  - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 17, 18, 19 & 20-19-13
- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 30 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 118 TO 120 PETITION BY G. W. WHITE FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 19-13 [PACKET 123 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON JULY 8, 1879, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JULY 12, 1879, AND RECORDED ON JULY 16, 1879 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT THIS ROAD PASSES OVER THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-13 FOR THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
  - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE TO A POINT 7,912-1/2 FEET SOUTH OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-13 TO A TURN TO THE EAST ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 3) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN SURVEY F19001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-13 FOR THE PARTIAL BOUNDARY LOCATION FOR A TRACT IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 19-19-13 BUT NOT DATED, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING A "**MONUMENT**" AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-13. THERE IS NO DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENT AND THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE KRETSINGER TIE BOOKS.
- HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 742.7' SOUTH TO THE IRON PIN HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST TRACT CORNER [HIS DESCRIPTION SHOWS 742.5' AS DOES AN AERIAL PHOTOGRAPH ATTACHED TO THE SURVEY]
