

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 91 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 185 AND DATED FEBRUARY 16, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY H. BROWN, BEING IN SECTION 20-19-13, TO DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 BY AN EAST AND WEST LINE, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-19-13 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-19-13 ON THIS SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 79 RODS, 12 LINKS NORTH TO THE HE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 20-19-13
 - 2) 79 RODS, 12 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 20-19-13

- 2) W. G. RUGGLES, COUNTY ENGINEER FROM 1915 TO 1928, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 175 THAT BEGAN APRIL 24, 1917 ORDERED BY BERT S. WHITE TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF HIS LAND IN SECTION 20-19-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-19-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
