

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

1) JAMES H. BROSEMER, L.S. 82, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED APRIL 1979, SURVEY F30001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-13 FOR A TRACT IN THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 30-19-13 FOR ERNEST JACKSON, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "BROSEMER LS 82" CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-13 AT THE INTERSECTION OF LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS.

- 1) 31.8' SOUTH TO A SPIKE & WASHER IN A POWER POLE
- 2) 18.0' SSE TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF A HEADWALL
- 3) 8.1' NE TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF A HEADWALL
- 4) 4.6' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF THE PUBLIC ROAD EAST-WEST

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 2,644.22' WEST TO THE 6" X 11" X 11" WHITE LIMESTONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-13 ON THE RANGE LINE
- 2) 1,566.70' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "BROSEMER LS 82" CAP HE SET ON THE SECTION LINE FOR A MEANDER CORNER
- 3) 2,645.07' NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 30-19-13 – FALLS IN THE NEOSHO RIVER
- 4) 781.75' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "BROSEMER LS 82" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST TRACT CORNER
- 5) 2,643.37' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "BROSEMER LS 82" CAP HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-13
- 6) 2,642.37' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "BROSEMER LS 82" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-13

2) WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED MARCH 26, 1997, **FOUND THE 1/2" REBAR WITH A RED "BROSEMER LS 82" CAP AT 6" BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE GRAVEL ROAD** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30-19-13 FROM EXISTING TIES OF RECORD IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE BY JAMES H. BROSEMER, L.S. 82, DATED APRIL 1979.

- 1) 7.6' NE TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTH HEADWAY OF A RCB
- 2) 25.1' ENE TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTH HEADWALL OF A RCB
- 3) 30.2' ESE TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTH HEADWALL OF A RCB
- 4) 27.8' ESE TO THE CENTER OF THE "9" IN THE DATE "1925" STAMPED ON THE SOUTH HEADWALL OF THE RCB
- 5) 18.4' SE TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTH HEADWALL OF A RCB
- 6) 4.6' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF ROAD 145 EAST-WEST
