

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 129 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 213 & 214 DATED JUNE 30, 1869 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE WESTERN BOUNDARY AND ALSO A CORER EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN IT AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER, AND ALSO BETWEEN IT AND THE NORTHWEST SECTION CORNER, AND ALSO CORRESPONDING CORNERS ON THE EASTERN BOUNDARY, AND ALSO RUN A LINE FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 TO CORRESPONDING CORNER ON THE WESTERN BOUNDARY AND ESTABLISH A CORNER 80 RODS, ALSO 88 RODS, AND 160 RODS, MORE OR LESS, ACCORDING TO THE SIZE OF THE SECTION, AND ALSO ESTABLISH THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-19-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-19-13 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-19-13 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 79 RODS, 10 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-19-13
- 2) 79 RODS, 10 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-19-13
- 3) 158 RODS, 18-1/2 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 33-19-13
- 4) 237 RODS, 27 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-19-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
