

**CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 03, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 82 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 139 DATED AUGUST 15, 1875 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS TO THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 3-20-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 14" X 8" X 6" STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 3-20-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 159-3/4 RODS [2,635-1/2'] EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-20-10
- 2) 1,315-3/4' WEST TO THE 14" X 6" X 6" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 3-20-10
- 3) 2,631-1/2' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-20-10
