

**NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 42 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 40" X 20" X 2"** FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 40.00 CHAINS WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 20" X 12" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 4 & 5-20-10
  - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 20" X 10" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 3 & 4-20-10
  
- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN **INFORMAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 158 DATED MAY 21, 1883 AT THE REQUEST OF McCORMICK TO ESTABLISH SECTION CORNERS IN SECTION 4-20-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-10 ON THIS INFORMAL SURVEY.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 40.00 CHAINS WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-10
  - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-10
