

NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 07, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 31 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 22" X 18" X 2"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 6 & 7-20-10 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE ON NOVEMBER 17, 1856.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.86 CHAINS EAST TO THE 22" X 16" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 6 & 7-20-10
 - 2) 80.86 CHAINS EAST TO THE 19" X 13" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 5, 6, 7 & 8-20-10
 - 3) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 24" X 16" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-20-10
 - 4) 80.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 28" X 9" X 4" LIMESTONE WITH A MOUND OF ROCKS THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 19 & 20 SOUTH, RANGES 9 & 10 EAST
 - 5) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 26" X 19" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-20-10
 - 6) 80.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 22" X 9" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7 & 18-20-10

- 2) ARTHUR MILLIKEN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F", ON PAGE 84 DATED DECEMBER 21, 1883 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20, RANGE 10 FOR ADAM STOTTER, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-20-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD SURVEY EXTENDED EAST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-20-10 ON THE RANGE LINE TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) HE NOTED ON HIS DRAWING THAT THE ROAD FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 3-20-10 TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-20-10 ON THE RANGE LINE WAS **DISALLOWED**

- 3) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 244 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 562 TO 564 PETITIONED BY ADAM STOTTER AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-10 [PACKET 490 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON DECEMBER 21, 1883, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD FROM THE PLACE OF BEGINNING TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-20-10 ON JANUARY 19, 1884 AS NOTED BY JOHN E. JONES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JANUARY 29, 1884 BY ROLAND LARKIN, COUNTY CLERK, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-20-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY. THE ROAD FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-20-10 TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-20-10 WAS **NOT ALLOWED**.

- 4) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 118, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 118 FOR TWO ROADS IN TOWNSHIP 20-10 FOR BY H. C. WOOD, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, DATED SEPTEMBER 8, 1885, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7-20-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) THE FIRST ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-21-10 TO BEGIN THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 5) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 308 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 182 TO 184 PETITIONED BY H. C. WOOD AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-10 [PACKET 536 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE], THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 8, 1885, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON OCTOBER 9, 1885 AS NOTED BY JOHN L. BUTLER, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JANUARY 29, 1886 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7-20-10 ON THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY. HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-20-10 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 6) CHARLES F. NESBIT, CHASE COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 312 ON THE CHASE AND LYON COUNTY LINE RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 198 TO 200 PETITION BY HENRY JACOBS AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD ON THE CHASE AND LYON COUNTY LINE [PACKET 574 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON NOVEMBER 30, 1885, WAS ESTABLISHED AT 20 FEET WIDE IN LYON COUNTY ON JANUARY 9, 1886 AS NOTED BY JOHN L. BUTLER, CHAIRMAN OF THE LYON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON FEBRUARY 5, 1886 BY ROLAND LAKIN, LYON COUNTY CLERK, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7-20-10 ON THE CHASE AND LYON COUNTY LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 19 & 20 OF RANGES 9 & 10 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTION 7-20-10 AND 12-20-9 TO THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 7) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 369 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 426 TO 428 PETITIONED BY R. B. SHEPPARD FOR THE VACATION AND RELOCATION OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-10 [PACKET 623 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE]. THE VACATED ROAD COMMENCED AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13 AND RAN WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2 MILES TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-20-13 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND CHASE COUNTY LINE. ON JANUARY 15, 1890 THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDERED THE ROAD VACATED AS PETITIONED AS NOTED BY S. V. BITLER, CHAIRMAN PROTEM, AND IT WAS RECORDED ON JANUARY 15, 1890 BY C. W. WILHITE, COUNTY CLERK.

THE PETITION SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON THE **VACATED** ROAD:

- 1) THE **VACATED** ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2 MILES TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-10 TO BEGIN THIS **VACATED** ROAD
