- 1) MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, FOR R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 125, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 125 DATED OCTOBER 23 & 24, 1885 ORDERED BY H. C. WOOD TO SURVEY SECTION 9 & 10-20-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 4-1/2" X 6" X 24" LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE NORTH SIDE AND A "+" ON THE BOTTOM** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-20-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
