

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, FOR R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 125, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 125 DATED OCTOBER 23 & 24, 1885 ORDERED BY H. C. WOOD TO SURVEY SECTION 9 & 10-20-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8" THAT MEASURED 8" X 6" AT THE BASE, 5" AT THE CENTER, THIN AT THE TOP AND 18" LONG** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-20-10 ON LINE AND AT THE PRORATED DISTANCE BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-19-10 AND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-20-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

BROSEMER, P.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F10001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-10 DATED AUGUST 24, 2015, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 15181-02, THE SURVEY OF TWO TRACTS IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-20-10 FOR LAMBERT/DOTY, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-20-10: **HE FOUND THE STONE SET BY BROWN LAI D OUT ± 3 FEET FROM THE TRUE POSITION**. THE STONE WAS AN 18" LONG TAPERED STONE MARKED "1/8" AND "+".
