

**CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 74 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 131 DATED JULY 1, 1875 TO DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 11-20-10 BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE SET A 20" X 10" X 4" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-20-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320-1/2' WEST TO THE TRUE POSITION FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 11-20-10 AS WITNESSED BY THE 30" X 8" X 8" STONE HE SET AT 33' NORTH AS THE TRUE POSITION FALLS IN DEEP WATER
  - 2) 2,641' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11-20-10
  - 3) 2,641' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11-20-10
  - 4) 2,642' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11-20-10
- 2) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "E" ON PAGE 31 AND DATED AUGUST 1914 FOR ROAD 674, SAID THAT HE BEGAN THIS ROAD SURVEY AT A POINT **60 RODS SOUTH** OF THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-20-10.
- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JUNE 24, 1989, FOR JOB NUMBER 89027, SAID THAT HE CONSIDERED THAT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-20-10 WAS **LOST**. **HE RESET THIS CORNER WITH A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-20-10.
- 1) 3.6' EAST TO A NORTH-SOUTH FENCE LINE
  - 2) 1.0' SOUTH TO A HEDGE TREE LINE TO THE WEST
  - 3) 5.35' WSW TO A NAIL & WASHER IN A 30" DIAMETER HEDGE TREE
  - 4) 5.05' SSW TO A NAIL & WASHER IN A 20" DIAMETER HEDGE TREE
  - 5) 1.0' EAST TO A HEDGE LINE TO THE NORTH
- 4) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED SEPTEMBER 2, 2008 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 08264-02, SURVEY F11003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-10 FOR THE SURVEY OF A 20.01 ACRE TRACT IN THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 11-20-10 FOR COREFIRST/RANDALL SMITH, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS RED "LS 752" CAP FROM A PRIOR SURVEY** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-20-10 FROM HIS EXISTING REFERENCES ON FILE IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE DATED JUNE 1989.
- 1) 4' EAST TO A NORTH-SOUTH FENCE
  - 2) 2.0' NW TO THE CENTER OF A 6" HEDGE
  - 3) 1' SOUTH TO A LINE OF HEDGE TO THE WEST
  - 4) 5.35' WSW TO A NAIL & WASHER IN A 30" HEDGE TREE

- 1) 1,731.49' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE 20.01 ACRE TRACT
  - 2) 2,589.49' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET ON THE WEST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF COUNTY ROAD "F"
  - 3) 2,639.49' EAST TO THE 5/8" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 11-20-10

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- 5) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MARCH 25, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10049-02, SURVEY F11004 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-10 FOR THE SURVEY OF A 7 ACRE TRACT IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 11-20-10 FOR STEVE ARNDT AND JOHN MOI, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-20-10 FROM HIS EXISTING REFERENCES ON FILE IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE DATED SEPTEMBER 2008.
- 1) 4' EAST TO A NORTH-SOUTH FENCE
  - 2) 2' NW TO THE CENTER OF A 6" HEDGE
  - 3) 1' SOUTH TO A LINE OF HEDGE TO THE WEST
  - 4) 5.35' WSW TO A NAIL & WASHER IN A 30" HEDGE TREE

- 1) 3,692.67' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 7 ACRE TRACT
  - 2) 2,622.67' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET ON THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF COUNTY ROAD 120
  - 3) 2,642.67' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 11-20-10
