- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 65 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 213 DATED AUGUST 5, 1872 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 14-20-10, SAID THAT "SOME BOY HAVING TAKEN AWAY MY TEMPORARY CENTER CORNER, **I SET A STONE** AT WHAT I SUPPOSED TO BE THE POINT" FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 14-20-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,315-1/2' WEST TO THE 12" X 8" X 2" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 14-20-10
- 2) 2,631' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14-20-10
- 3) 2,642-1/2' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14-20-10
- 4) 2,642-1/2' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14-20-10
