- 1) E. C. GOLDSMITH, COUNTY ENGINEER FROM 1944 TO 1949, BY W. D. KRETSINGER, L.S. 363, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN **INFORMAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 78 DATED AUGUST 20, 1947, TO LOCATE THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-20-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 15-20-10 ON THIS **INFORMAL SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,308.0' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 15-20-13
- 2) 2,616.0' WEST TO THE TEMPORARY POINT HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-20-10 IN THE CENTER OF THE ROAD RUNNING NORTH AND ON LINE WITH A SECTION LINE FENCE RUNNING SOUTH
- 3) 1,324.1' NORTH TO THE TEMPORARY POINT HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 15-20-10
- 4) 2,648.3' NORTH TO THE TEMPORARY POINT HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-20-10 ON LINE WITH A FENCE RUNNING SOUTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE
