

**WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

1) ON PAGE 237 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 22" X 17" X 5"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 16 & 17-20-10.

2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 103, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 184 DATED OCTOBER 18, 1904 FOR J. H. THEYE, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, FOR A ROAD IN SECTION 16 IN TOWNSHIP 20-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-10 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY. HE NOTED "ALL PARTIES INTERESTED BEING PRESENT AND SATISFIED THAT THE FENCE EXTENDING EAST AND WEST IS ON THE LINE, NO FURTHER SURVEY WAS MADE." HE DID NOT INDICATE THE WIDTH OF THE ROAD IN HIS NOTES.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE FOR 30 LINKS TO A FENCE ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE ROAD, THEN CONTINUES EAST ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE AND AT 40.13 CHAINS EAST INTERSECTS A FENCE EXTENDING NORTH, THEN CONTINUES EAST ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE AND AT 80.41 CHAINS INTERSECTS THE CENTER OF THE ROAD ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 16-20-10 TO THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY – **NO STONE** WAS FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-20-10

3) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 592 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "D" ON PAGES 237 THROUGH 240 PETITIONED BY JOHN H. THEYE AND OTHERS FOR THE LOCATION AND VACATION OF ROADS IN TOWNSHIP 20-10 [PACKET 735 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON NOVEMBER 10, 1904, WAS GRANTED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD, 20 FEET EACH SIDE OF THE SURVEYED LINE, ON MARCH 3, 1905 AS NOTED BY JOHN LANGLEY, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, ATTESTED BY W. F. EGGERS, COUNTY CLERK, AND RECORDED ON MARCH 3, 1905 BY ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-10 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY. HE NOTED "ALL PARTIES INTERESTED BEING PRESENT AND SATISFIED THAT THE FENCE EXTENDING EAST AND WEST IS ON THE LINE, NO FURTHER SURVEY WAS MADE."

HIS NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE FOR 30 LINKS TO A FENCE ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE ROAD, THEN CONTINUES EAST ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE AND AT 40.13 CHAINS EAST INTERSECTS A FENCE EXTENDING NORTH, THEN CONTINUES EAST ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE AND AT 80.41 CHAINS INTERSECTS THE CENTER OF THE ROAD ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 16-20-10 TO THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY – **NO STONE** WAS FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-20-10
