- 1) ON PAGE 244 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 27" X 16" X 1/2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 7 & 18-20-10.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.60 CHAINS WEST TO THE 22" X 9" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7 & 18-20-10 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND COUNTY LINE
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 30" X 14" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7, 8, 17 & 18-20-10

- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN INFORMAL SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 152 DATED APRIL 6, 1883 AT THE REQUEST OF KEYS TO SURVEY SECTIONS 17 & 18-20-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-20-10 ON TRUE LINE AND AT 40.00 CHAINS WEST OF THE STONE THAT THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 17-20-10 ON THIS INFORMAL SURVEY.
