- 1) ON PAGE 30 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 22" X 9" X 6"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7 & 18-20-10 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE ON NOVEMBER 17, 1856.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.60 CHAINS EAST TO THE 27" X 16" X 1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 7 & 18-20-10
- 2) 80.60 CHAINS EAST TO THE 30" X 14" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7, 8, 17 & 18-20-10
- 3) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 19" X 14" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-20-10
- 4) 80.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 34" X 21" X 1-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 18 & 19-20-10
