

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 242 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 19" X 16" X 2-1/2"** FOR THE /4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 17 & 20-20-10.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.10 CHAINS WEST TO THE 24" X 12" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 17, 18, 19 & 20-20-10
 - 2) 40.10 CHAINS EAST TO THE 24" X 16" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 16, 17, 20 & 21-20-10

- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN **INFORMAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 152 DATED APRIL 6, 1883 AT THE REQUEST OF KEYS TO SURVEY SECTIONS 17 & 18-20-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-20-10 ON THIS **INFORMAL SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 20.03 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 17-20-10
 - 2) 40.06 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 17-20-10
 - 3) 80.06 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-20-10
