

**NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 232 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 14" X 1-1/2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 22 & 27-20-10.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 39.96 CHAINS WEST TO THE 32" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 21, 22, 27 & 28-20-10
  - 2) 39.96 CHAINS EAST TO THE 19" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 22, 23, 26 & 27-20-10
  
- 2) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 160  
ON MARCH 6, 1972 A PETITION SIGNED BY WALTER E. HALEY FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-10 WAS PRESENTED TO ROSEMARY SPALDING, COUNTY CLERK. THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS VIEWED THE ROAD ON MARCH 30, 1972 AND RECOMMENDED THAT THE FOLLOWING ROAD BE **VACATED:**
  - 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-10; THENCE SOUTH 1 MILE ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 22; THENCE EAST 1/2 MILE ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 22-20-10 AND THERE ENDING.
