- 1) ON PAGE 30 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 26" X 10" X 2"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-10 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE ON NOVEMBER 17, 1856.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 17" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-20-10
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 33" X 7" X 7" LIMESTONE THEY SET ON A GENTLE SLOPE TO THE SOUTHEAST AT THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGES 9 & 10 EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL
