- 1) ON PAGE 13 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE ROCK 25" X 9" X 5"** ON A SLOPE TO THE NORTHEAST FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 32 & 33-21-10 ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL ON NOVEMBER 17, 1855.

**THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE 23" X 10" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET ON A SLOPE TO THE EAST FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-20-10
- 2) 80.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO A 28" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE SET ON A SLOPE TO THE SOUTHWEST FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 33 & 34-20-10
