- 1) ON PAGE 14 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE ROCK 23" X 11" X 3"** ON A SLOPE TO THE EAST FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-20-10 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL ON NOVEMBER 17, 1855.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS WEST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE 28" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET ON A SLOPE TO THE SOUTHWEST FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 33 & 34-20-10
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE 25" X 8" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET ON A SLOPE TO THE SOUTH FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 34 & 35-20-10
