

**CENTER CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN SURVEY F05001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-11 TO SURVEY TO ESTABLISH AND SET THE CORNERS OF A 40 ACRE TRACT OF GROUND DESCRIBED AT THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 5-20-11 DATED MAY 17, 1973, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING AN **IRON PIN** AT THE CENTER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-11.

- 8) 1,319.60' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR PAINTED ORANGE ON TOP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-11 ATTRIBUTABLE TO L. M. GOULD SURVEYS DATED MAY AND JULY 1974
