COWEN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 116, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** AT THE REQUEST OF GEORGE CRICKLAND TO ESTABLISH THE LINES AND CORNERS OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-20-11 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 132 DATED MAY 1-9, 1888, SAID **HE SET A 24" X 14" X 9" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH A PLUS ("+" ) ON THE TOP AND ON THE WEST SIDE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 6-20-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE TEMPORARY POINTS THAT HE SET FOR THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
