- 1) 222.88' NORTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP [**HORIZONTAL TIE**]
- 2) 0.7' SOUTH TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE EAST EXTENDED
- 3) 19.20' NE TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN A BRACE POST
- 4) 10.65' EAST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A CORNER FENCE POST
- 5) 10.5' EAST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE NORTH

- 3) 1,289.98' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR A WITNESS CORNER
- 4) 1,318.98' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 7-20-11
- 5) 1,292.37' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET ON THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF COUNTY ROAD 110
- 6) 1,317.12' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 7-20-11

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
