

**WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 75, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** AT THE REQUEST OF W. C. LONG RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 155 DATED JUNE 16 & 17, 1903, FOR A SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-11, AND THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SAID SECTION 12 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A STONE "SET BY UNKNOWN PARTY"** AT 60.30 CHAINS NORTH OF THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-11 AND 19.85 CHAINS SOUTH OF THE STONE THAT SET FOR AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE DOES **NOT** REFER TO THIS STONE AS THE WEST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER THE NORTHWEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-11, AND HE DOES **NOT** SHOW THIS CORNER ON HIS DRAWING. THE STONE IS 0.18 CHAINS NORTH OF BEING HALFWAY BETWEEN THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AS ESTABLISHED AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-11. IT IS LISTED HERE TO ONLY SHOW THE ORIGIN OF THIS STONE. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 3 ON PAGE 172 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 162" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 8 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.21 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-11 AS ESTABLISHED BY THE AFFIDAVIT OF J. R. MADDOCK THAT THE STONE ORIGINALLY STOOD ON LINE WITH THE HEDGE AT THIS CORNER AND 20 FEET WEST OF THE HEDGE ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE ROAD
- 2) 60.30 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-11
- 3) 19.85 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 14" X 8" X 3" STONE HE SET ON THE WEST SIDE OF A CULVERT FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-11. HE DROVE A 1/2" IRON ROD UNDER A STONE AT 20 FEET EAST AND 24 FEET NORTH OF THE CORNER
- 4) 99.22 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 1-20-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
