

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 60 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 208 DATED JUNE 21, 1872 TO SUBDIVIDE THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 BY A LINE RUNNING EAST & WEST, AND ALSO TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 16-20-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,317' NORTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE TEMPORARY WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-11
- 2) 2,634' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-20-11
