

**CENTER CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 60 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 208 DATED JUNE 21, 1872 TO SUBDIVIDE THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 BY A LINE RUNNING EAST & WEST, AND ALSO TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/4/4 CORNER IN THE CENTER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,339' WEST TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE TEMPORARY WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-11
2) 1,317' EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-11

[NOTE: ACCORDING TO HIS NOTES, HE MEASURED 2,656' BETWEEN THE 1/2/4 CORNERS EAST AND WEST, BUT HIS DRAWING SHOWS ONLY THE 1,317' ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE SE1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-11 – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]

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
