

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) SAMUEL P. DAVIES, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 65, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 63 DATED AUGUST 6, 1870 TO ESTABLISH QUARTER QUARTER CORNERS OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 22-20-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 20.83-1/2 CHAINS NORTH TO THE POST THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 22-20-11
 - 2) 41.67 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-11
 - 3) 19.76-3/4 CHAINS EAST TO THE POST THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-11
 - 4) 39.53-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-11

- 2) JAMES H. BROSEMER, L.S. 82, KDOT CHIEF OF SURVEYS, FOR KDOT PROJECT 57-56-K0548-01, SAID THAT HE **COMPUTED** THE LOCATION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-11 TO BE AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE 1/4 SECTION LINES AND 1.30' LEFT OR WEST OF CENTERLINE STATION 315 + 45.05 AT A RIGHT ANGLE TO THE CENTERLINE, BUT HE DID **NOT** SET A MONUMENT FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-11.

- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 11, 1990, FOR JOB NUMBER 90074, SAID THAT HE CONSIDERED THAT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-11 WAS **OBLITERATED** AFTER THE RECONSTRUCTION OF K-57/99 HIGHWAY. **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-11.
 - 1) 64.5' ENE TO A NAIL & SHINER IN A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 2) 61.5' ENE TO THE CENTERLINE OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY MARKER
 - 3) 1.6' EAST TO THE CENTERLINE OF TRAVELED WAY OF K-57/99
 - 4) 116.0' SW TO A NAIL & WASHER IN A POWER POLE
 - 5) 64.3' WNW TO THE TOP OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY MARKER
 - 6) 120.0' NNW TO A NAIL & SHINER IN A POWER POLEHIS DRAWING ON HIS REFERENCE REPORT SHOWS THE FOLLOWING:
 - 1) 2,633.64' NORTH TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-11
