

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 393 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 13" X 2-1/2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 21 & 22-20-11.

- 2) JAMES H. BROSEMER, L.S. 82, KDOT CHIEF OF SURVEYS, FOR KDOT PROJECT 57-56-K0548-01, IN 1981, SAID THAT HE EXCAVATED WITH A COUNTY MOTOR GRADER FOR THE STONE AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-11, BUT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE. HE DEEMED THAT THIS CORNER WAS **OBLITERATED**. **HE SET A 1/2" REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM KDOT CAP STAMPED "W 1/4 22-20-11"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-20-11 BASED ON THE PHYSICAL EVIDENCE THAT HE FOUND AT THIS CORNER; I.E., IN THE CENTER OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF THE NORTH-SOUTH ROAD AND IN LINE WITH AN OLD FENCE TO THE EAST.
 - 1) 19.5' EAST TO A SPIKE & KDOT WASHER SET IN THE SIDE OF A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 2) 26.7' NE TO A SPIKE & KDOT WASHER SET IN THE SIDE OF A FENCE POST
 - 3) 38.7' NW TO A SPIKE & KDOT WASHER SET IN THE TOP OF A FENCE POST
 - 4) IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE EAST

- 3) DOUGLAS A. FARRAR, L.S. 720, OF SHAFER, KLINE & WARREN, INC., IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JULY 7, 2005, FOR JOB NUMBER 104753, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE IRON BAR WITH AN ALUMINUM CAP AT 1 FOOT DEEP** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-20-11 RECOVERED FROM OLD REFERENCE TIES. HE SENT THE FOLLOWING **HORIZONTAL TIES**:
 - 1) 19.84' EAST TO A 40 D NAIL & KDOT WASHER FOUND IN THE SOUTH SIDE OF A LEANING FENCE POST
 - 2) 42.14' NORTHWEST TO A MAG NAIL & SHINER SET IN THE NORTHEAST SIDE OF A GATE POST
 - 3) 25.82' WEST TO A REDHEAD & SHINER SET IN A STEEL FENCE POST
 - 4) 43.05' SOUTHWEST TO A REDHEAD & SHINER SET IN A STEEL FENCE POST
 - 5) 4.5' WEST TO THE CENTERLINE OF THE NORTH-SOUTH GRAVEL TRAVELWAY
