

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 86, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 86 FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-11 FOR W. D. FRANKS, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, DATED FEBRUARY 24, 1885, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-20-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. THIS PORTION OF THE ROAD SURVEY WAS **DISALLOWED** ON ACCOUNT OF EXCESSIVE DAMAGES BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

- 2) ARTHUR MILLIKEN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 291 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 114 TO 116 PETITIONED BY W. D. FRANKS AND OTHERS FOR 2 ROADS IN TOWNSHIPS 20-11 AND 21-11 [PACKET 527 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON FEBRUARY 24, 1885, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 33-2-11 TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-11 – THE REST OF THE ROAD ON THE PETITION WAS **DISALLOWED** ON ACCOUNT OF EXCESSIVE DAMAGES BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON APRIL 21, 1885 AS NOTED BY JOHN L. BUTLER, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON MAY 16, 1885 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 28-20-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. THIS PORTION OF ROAD WAS **DISALLOWED** BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
