

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 26 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 173 DATED MARCH 25, 1872 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS TO THE EAST AND WEST HALVES OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-20-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST ON THE PRAIRIE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-20-11 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-20-11 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 34-20-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 712' EAST TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF A 20 ACRE LOT
- 2) 1,310' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 34-20-11
- 3) 1,310' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-20-11
