

**SOUTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 26 OF THE 7<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 173 DATED MARCH 25, 1872 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS TO THE EAST AND WEST HALVES OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-20-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST ON THE HIGH PRAIRIE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-20-11 ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-20-11 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-20-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,327' WEST ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-20-11
- 2) 1,327' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-20-11
