

CENTER CORNER SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 123 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 210 & 211 DATED MAY 31, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND SITUATED IN SECTION 26-20-11, TO SURVEY THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, AND THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, AND ALSO THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 36, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-20-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF TH LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 79 RODS, 1-1/2 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 36-20-11
 - 2) 158 RODS, 3 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 36-20-11 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL
