

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 03, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 25 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 80 DATED MAY 20, 1874 TO SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12 INTO EAST AND WEST HALVES, SAID THAT **HE SET A 15" X 10" X 2-1/2" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-19-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-19-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,318' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-19-12
 - 2) 1,318' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND ON THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-19-12
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, IN SURVEY F34002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 FOR THE SURVEY OF A 57.3 ACRE TRACT LYING IN THE NORTH HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 34-19-12 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 88219 DATED OCTOBER 14, 1988, SAID THAT HE DEEMED THAT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12 WAS **LOST**. HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE CORNER TO BE ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-19-12 AND THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-19-12, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT MONUMENTED** ON THIS SURVEY.

- 1) 1,318.32' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-19-12
- 2) 1,318.32' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-19-12
- 3) 3,954.96' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-19-12
- 4) 1,327.47' NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F34003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 FOR A SURVEY OF THE SOUTH 660 FEET OF THE WEST 660 FEET OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 34-19-12 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 03203-02 DATED MAY 28, 2003, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE SET A COTTON GIN SPINDLE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12 AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12. THIS CORNER IS ALSO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE TRACT BEING SURVEYED.

 - 4) 50' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR A **WITNESS CORNER**
 - 5) 660.00' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SURVEYED TRACT
 - 6) 1,327.47' NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12
 - 7) 2,654.94' NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, IN SURVEY F34004 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 FOR THE SURVEY OF A 20 ACRE TRACT IN THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 34-19-12 FOR MIKE ARNDT, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10258-02 DATED OCTOBER 19, 2010, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND THE COTTON GIN SPINDLE** AT THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE.  - 3) 984.43' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE COTTON GIN SPINDLE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 20 ACRE TRACT AS WITNESSED BY THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET AT 50' NORTH
 - 4) 1,318.32' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND IN A MONUMENT WELL AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12

 - 7) 2,654.94' NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-19-12
