

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 03, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 557 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 11" X 5"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 3 & 4-20-12.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 41.20 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 24" X 9" X 3-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 3 & 4-20-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 18" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 3, 4, 9 & 10-20-12

- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 109 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 94 DATED APRIL 21 & 22, 1886, REQUESTED BY JOHN REIGLIN TO ESTABLISH THE LINES AND CORNERS OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-20-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-12 ON THIS SURVEY. HE USED THIS STONE TO SET THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-12.
