

**CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) W. G. RUGGLES, COUNTY ENGINEER FROM 1915 TO 1928, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 697 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "E" ON PAGE 54 PETITIONED BY JAMES W. VANCLEVE AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-12 [PACKET 788 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE COUNTY SURVEYOR ON AUGUST FEBRUARY 8, 1915 AND WAS ORDERED THAT THE ROAD BE GRANTED BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-20-12, THENCE NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES 3/4 MILES TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 3-20-12 AND ENDING THERE, SAID ROAD TO BE 40 FEET WIDE, 20 FEET EACH SIDE OF THE SECTION LINE, ON SEPTEMBER 10, 1915 AS NOTED BY E. MOORHEAD, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SHOWS ON THE *RETURN OF SURVEY AND PLAT* THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-12. THIS CORNER WAS NOT A PART OF THE ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY, BUT WAS APPARENTLY USED TO LOCATE THE SECTION LINE BETWEEN SECTIONS 4 AND 5-20-12. THIS ROAD WAS RECORDED ON JANUARY 1, 1916 BY W. S. RUGGLES, COUNTY SURVEYOR.
  
- 2) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN SURVEY F05001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-12 SHOWING THE RESULTS OF A SURVEY OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-12 DATED SEPTEMBER 15, 1975, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A "**THEORETICAL POSITION**" FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-12, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.  
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 1,317' WEST TO THE "MONUMENT" HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-12 – NOT DESCRIBED
  - 2) 2,634' WEST TO THE "MONUMENT" AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-12 – NOT DESCRIBED
  - 3) 2,634' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-12
  - 4) 2,640' SOUTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-12
  
- 3) MARION WAYNE BLACKBOURN, L.S. 1127, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN LARGE SURVEY SR #05001 IN THE SURVEY DRAWER FOR TOWNSHIP 20-12 DATED NOVEMBER 27, 1994 FOR JOB NUMBER 93-12-054, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A **CALCULATED POSITION** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-12, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.  
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 1,318.54' WEST TO THE SOUTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-12 – NOT DESCRIBED
  - 2) 2,637.28' WEST TO THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-12 – NOT DESCRIBED
  - 3) 2,650.42' NORTH TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE – NOT DESCRIBED
  - 4) 2,637.27' EAST TO THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-12 – NOT DESCRIBED
