

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 60 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 23" X 11" X 3"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-20-12 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY ON DECEMBER 4, 1856.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 30" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE WITH A MOUND OF ROCKS THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 19 & 20 SOUTH, RANGES 11 & 12 EAST AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-20-12
- 2) 40.00 SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 23" X 8" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 6 & 7-20-12
- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 75, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** AT THE REQUEST OF W. C. LONG RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 155 DATED JUNE 16 & 17, 1903, FOR A SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-11, AND THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SAID SECTION 12 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, APPARENTLY DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-20-11 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY** AS HE RAN THE RANGE LINE FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-20-11, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE AFFIDAVITS OF J. B. BURDEN AND W. B. ROSS AT 23-1/2' EAST AND 23-1/2 FEET NORTH OF THE CORNER OF THE HEDGE SOUTH, TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 12-10-11, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE WITNESS STONES THAT HE FOUND AT 33 FEET NORTH AND 82-1/2 FEET EAST OF THE TRUE CORNER. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 3 ON PAGE 172 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 162" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 8 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED DECEMBER 22, 2009 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 09330-02, SURVEY F01001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-11 FOR THE SURVEY OF THE EAST HALF OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 1-20-11 FOR NORMAN GEIGER, SAID THAT HE CONSIDERED THAT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-20-11 ON THE RANGE LINE WAS **LOST**. **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-20-11 ON THE RANGE LINE AT HALFWAY BETWEEN THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-20-11.
- 1) 23.20' ESE TO THE WEST END OF AN 18" IRON PIPE
- 2) 12.30' SW TO THE TOP EAST END OF A CMP
- 3) IN LINE WITH A HEDGE TO THE WEST EXTENDED
- 4) 6.0' EAST TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF COUNTY ROAD "N" NORTH-SOUTH
- HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 2,638.32' NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP IN A MONUMENT WELL HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 1-20-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
- 2) 2,638.32' SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SE1/4 OF SEC. 1-20-11
- 3) 2,633.69' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 1-20-11

- 4) 3,950.56' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 1-20-11
- 5) 5,267.43' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 1-20-11
