

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) SAMUEL P. DAVIES, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 62, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 60 DATED JULY 1, 1870 TO REESTABLISH THE 1/4 SECTION CORNER ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 12-20-12, THE CENTER CORNER, AND TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE SET A LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 215 AND DATED OCTOBER 1872, SAID THAT **HE SET A WALNUT POST** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 12-20-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
