- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED MAY 10, 2008 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 08140-02, SURVEY F16001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-12 FOR THE SURVEY OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 16-20-12 FOR JOE BIGGS, SAID THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12 TO BE AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE QUARTER CORNERS, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320.77' WEST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12
- 2) 2,641.55' WEST TO THE 3/4" IRON PIN HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12
- 3) 1,323.77' NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12
- 4) 2,645.45' NORTH TO THE 4" X 8" X 14" LIMESTONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12
- 5) 2,648.84' EAST TO THE 5/8" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12 ATTRIBUTABLE TO L. M. GOULD
- 6) 2,646.57' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12
